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1. PROPOSALS

- Bids need to be submitted/uploaded to SmartBidNet.
- Budgets shall contain all anticipated costs to construct the trade scope.
- Costs will need to be provided on subcontractor proposals forms broken down by:
 - Building Each bldg. cost should be a stand-alone price & proposal with deduct if awarded both projects.

HVAC

- Trade If bidding multiple trades (i.e. structural concrete, site concrete, masonry, framing, sheet metal, roofing, etc...)
- Areas Off-Site (Gene Autry Blvd. & State College), On-Site, Residential, Garage, Amenity (leasing, lounge, fitness, etc...), Public Park @ Bldg. B



- Each Building shall be priced as a stand-alone project with deduct if awarded both.
- All proposals shall be per plans and specifications. Substitutions can be proposed as an alternate SEPARATE from your base bid proposal.
- Bidders shall provide their project specific qualifications and exclusions to their proposal.

2. ESCALATION

Your proposal should be priced as if it were an immediate start and include escalation through the current project duration (26 mo.).

3. DOCUMENTS

The subcontractor is responsible to view and evaluate all of the documents provided on SmartBidNet in the preparation of a proposal. 4. WAGE REQUIREMENTS

5. BOND REQUIREMENTS

Subcontractors may be required to provide a payment and performance bond(s) as part of the Subcontract. As part of your proposal, you will be required to provide your bond rate which JPI will calculate separately. After bid, and at JPI's sole discretion, if JPI determines such bonds are not necessary, the final subcontract and price will be adjusted accordingly.



6. INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

Subcontractors bidding must meet the insurance requirements below:

Workers Compensation Coverage:

Minimum \$1,000,000 General Aggregate

Minimum \$1,000,000 Each Occurrence

Minimum \$50,000 Fire Damage (any one fire)

Minimum \$5,000 Medical Expense (any one person)

Automobile Liability:

Any Auto, All Owned Autos, Hired Autos, Non-Hired Autos

Minimum Combined Single Limit \$1,000,000

Minimum Bodily Injury \$1,000,000 (any one person)

Minimum Bodily Injury \$1,000,000 (any one accident)

Property Damage \$1,000,000

(Excess of above underlying limits of Employer's Liability and Auto Liability)

Umbrella Liability:

Minimum \$2,000,000 Per Occurrence

Minimum \$2,000,000 Aggregate

Umbrella Liability for High Risk Vendors Only:

Minimum \$3,000,000 Per Occurrence

Minimum \$3,000,000 Aggregate

The following vendors are considered HIGH RISK: Framers, Plumbers, Electricians (not low voltage), Utilities (wet only), Roofers, HVAC, Painters, Rain Guttering, Exterior Veneer (stuccobrick-siding), Steel Erectors, Precast Concrete (garages), Elevator, Temporary Man hoist, Plasterer/EIFS, Concrete Shell, Glazing, Window Cleaning, Trusses, Scaffold, Crane, Caulk/Sealant, Trash Disposal Service, Excavators, Demolition, Formwork, Lightening Protection, Curtain Wall.

All Carriers must have an A8 Rating or Better. Additional insured information must be listed.



7. ADDITIONAL BID NOTES

The Bidder shall clearly indicate on his/her proposal:

- Receipt and acknowledgement of all addendum.
- Inclusion of all applicable taxes.
- Acknowledgement and ability to meet JPI's insurance requirements.
- Inclusion of equipment and hoisting for bidders scope of work.
